



Erasmus+ KA107 (ICM) Student Call for Studies and Internship

Project No: 2020-1-TR01-KA107-088287

Application Period for 2021-2022 Spring Academic Year

Application Criteria:

1. Relevant departments and quotas for application are given **Annex-1**.
2. The application calendar is given at the end of this document.
3. Learning mobility is that the student performs a part of his/her education (1 semester) in a partner Higher Education institution through an agreement between institutions. For the application for learning mobility, the student must have completed at least 1 year in the registered program.
4. Internship mobility is the gaining of practical work experience about the vocational education of the educational program/department of the student. Internship activity cannot be used to carry out studies such as research assignments and analysis studies related to academic studies within the scope of a certain curriculum.
5. The grant for studies mobility is for one semester (4 months). Therefore, students are kindly requested to choose spring semester of 2021-2022 academic year.
6. The grant for internship mobility is for 2 months.
7. Being a full-time student is a must to apply. A full-time student is a student who has not yet completed the studies required by his/her diploma degree and is expected to have a course load of 30 ECTS credits in one semester.
8. For studies mobility, the student is required to take 30 ECTS course load in the semester he/she will attend. For internship mobility, the student must be a full-time student until the end of the internship process. There is no internship opportunity after graduation.
9. All students can apply, except for prep students and those studying in distance education programs.
10. Only the students who have **a CGPA of at least 2.20/4.00 in the undergraduate level and at least 2.50/4.00 in the graduate level** are able to apply to the mobility.

Selection Process & Language Proficiency:

1. While calculating the general point, the following evaluation criteria will be applied:

- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA): **50 %**

- Language Proficiency*: **50 %**

*Students can have the foreign language exam score from the Foreign Language Exam organized by their home university. They can also use the score of TOEFL, IELTS or National Exam score. Any foreign language certificate can also be accepted. When there is more than one student having the same result, they will be interviewed.

2. Starting from the highest score, the applicants are placed to their preferred study programmes, according to the university quotas.

- In the selection process, **10 points** will be decreased for each mobility of the students who already attend to an Erasmus program conducted by AKU. 10 points will be decreased from the student who attended to one program, **20 points** from the one who attend two programs.

- The students who are selected but want to withdraw from the program will be given a waiving period. If the students do not inform the International Office that they want to withdraw from the program within this period, there will be a **10 point** decrease in their further applications for any Erasmus+ mobility program (Erasmus+ European Mobility, Erasmus+ Traineeship, Erasmus+ ICM).

- The students with disability who also have an official report will be given an extra **10 points** in their overall scores. The related report should be submitted to the online application system within the application period. Extra point will not be applicable if the report is not submitted.

- In case of applying to more than one mobility type (studies and internship) at the same time, **10 points** are reduced for the mobility that the student will prefer.

- For the students who have Turkish nationality, there will be a **10 point** decrease from their total point.

3. All students will be subject to the same type of selection process

How to Apply:

1. The application is made ONLINE (<https://forms.gle/JZMgiqQzVGxYMqG78>)

- **Current student certificate (signed and stamped)**
- **Current Transcript of Records (signed and stamped)**
- **Document of Language Proficiency**

2. Applications must be made through online application.

Scholarship & Cost:

1. Erasmus+ KA107 Individual support grant is given in the table below.

Individual Support	800 (per month)

1. Individual Support grant will be calculated not on a monthly basis, but on the basis of the days spent abroad.
2. Learning mobility period is at least 3 months. Internship mobility period is at least 2 months. This period cannot be reduced except for force majeure. If learning mobility is less than 3 months and internship mobility is less than 2 months, no grant payment is made for this mobility.
3. At the end of the Erasmus+ Exchange Program, the payment of the 20% of the grant will not be made to the students who are not successful from at least 20 ECTS out of 30.
4. Travel support will change between **275€ and 1500€** according to the city of the university where the student is coming from. The distance between Afyonkarahisar and the specific city is calculated via the following link:
