<b>PRONUNCIATION &amp; FLUENCY</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Speaks <b>clearly</b> and at a <b>natural pace</b> with <b>intelligible pronunciation</b></li><li>Uses <b>natural intonation</b></li><li>Avoids <u>long pauses, hesitation, and unnecessary self-correction</u></li><li>Avoids <u>using Turkish</u> (their first language)</li><li>Minor pronunciation difficulties lapses do not affect overall intelligibility.</li></ul>	0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5
